## ZIPAQUIRA SALT CATHEDRAL

The Salt Cathedral of Zipaquirá is an underground Church built in a tunnel of salt mines 200 mts inside a salt mountain near the town of Zipaquirá, in Cundinamarca, Colombia. The Salt Cathedral has been voted one of Colombia's "seven wonders" by readers of the most popular newspaper.

Zipaquirá is located 49 km from Bogota.<sup>3</sup>

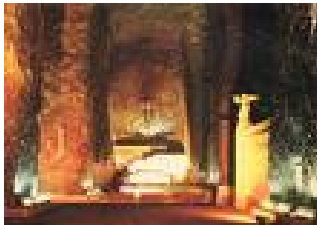

## ZIPAQUIRA SALT CATHEDRAL - GUATAVITA



Full day tour to visit Zipaquirá's Salt Cathedral and Guatavita's lake.



**The Salt Cathedral of Zipaquirá** is an underground Church built in a tunnel of salt mines 200 mts inside a salt mountain near the town of Zipaquirá, in Cundinamarca, Colombia. Zipaquirá is located 49 km from Bogota.

**Lake Guatavita** is located in the municipality of Sesquilé, in the Cundinamarca department of Colombia. It is a circular lake in what appears to be a meteor crater. However, the origins of the crater are unclear. Lake Guatavita was one of the sacred lakes of the Muiscas, where they celebrated a ceremony in which the chief (*The Zipa*) was covered in gold before bathing in its waters. This is one of the origins of the legend of El Dorado. Guatavita today bears a curious notch in its cliffside, evidence of an attempt to drain the lake by the conquistadores in 1580. Guatavita is located 75km from Bogota.<sup>4</sup>

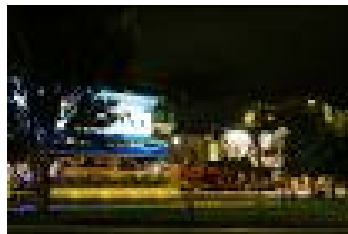
