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Summary

- ▶ Is the reporting of wasteful spending in Germany used by the media to set (or not) their agenda for current government.
- ▶ An independent agency (BRH) determines the wasteful spending.
- ▶ The paper uses several newspapers to find if they over / under report wasteful spending based on the agency announcement.
- ▶ Two center left newspapers report less. If right wing party in government, lower reporting.
- ▶ Far left / right wing newspapers seem to not over / under report.

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- ▶ Maybe overspending happens in years of fiscal buoyancy, this can be included in the analysis.
- ▶ Why keep using the lineal probability model, instead of logit / probit? Needs an explanation.
